At Samaritan Healthcare, we're happy to welcome you back to safely receive the care you need. If you have a concern about your physical or emotional health, we're here to help through virtual visits (via internet access or by telephone) or in-person visits.

We know you may feel a bit apprehensive about returning to the hospital or clinic so we're taking extra precautions to keep you safe.

Samaritan Hospital and Clinics

Clinics and hospitals always have high standards when it comes to cleaning and keeping germs from spreading. We have taken additional, concrete steps to keep you safe when you seek care:

- Screening for symptoms and temperature when anyone patients, staff, and visitors—arrives at the hospital or clinics, often before they even enter the building.
- Separating people with COVID-like symptoms from others. All COVID-19 testing is located at our drive-through testing site outside of Samaritan Clinic on Pioneer. All hospitalized COVID-19 patients are cared for in a special unit of the hospital, away from other patients.
- Limiting visitors for appointments and patients.

- Distancing people from one another with visual reminders, waiting room chairs placed six feet apart, protective barriers in some areas, including plexiglass at registration desks.
- Increasing the use of masks for staff, patients, and visitors.
- Sanitizing exam rooms and waiting areas multiple times a day.
- Increasing cleaning of high-touch items, such as door handles, elevator buttons, tables, and chairs.

Telemedicine Appointments

When patients call for appointments, they will be asked questions so their providers can determine if an in-person appointment is needed or if a telemedicine appointment may be scheduled.

- Telemedicine video appointments are offered via internet access on your digital device.
- Televisit telephone appointments are also an option for those who may not have internet access or do not own a device that allows video calls.




