Dr. Warfield also has extensive training in inflammatory bowel disease, such as Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis.

“In gastroenterology, we spend a lot of time on preventive-care procedures—screening for colorectal cancer, identifying and removing benign colon polyps, and preventing cancer from starting,” said Dr. Warfield. “Most of these procedures begin at age 50, but family history may allow for procedures to be done even earlier.”

Preventive care and disease management

In addition to providing diagnosis and treatment, our Gastroenterology department offers preventive care, such as management of chronic liver disease, inflammatory bowel disease, and pancreatic disorder. Dr. Warfield also performs preventive procedures such as upper endoscopies and colonoscopies.

Specialized fellowship training

Dr. Warfield earned his Doctor of Medicine from The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine in Baltimore, Maryland. He completed his residency and a fellowship in gastroenterology at University of Chicago, in Illinois, where he also completed an inflammatory bowel disease clinical fellowship working with the trailblazing, world-renowned gastroenterologist Dr. Joseph B. Kirsner.

Dr. Warfield is also a Fellow of the American Gastroenterological Association, the nation's most prestigious medical society dedicated to gastrointestinal disorders.
